Barb Brody: Update on schools. Public schools start Sept 8<sup>th</sup>. Drivers ed will resume with limited classroom contact and virtual classes. Low percentages for people buckled in the back seat. When belt laws are primary, the backseat percentages increase.

Stephanie Busch, DOH: Car seat program has started again with car seat fitting stations with social distancing guidelines. DOH has also started car seat technician training program. Sid has developed guidelines that are being used by other states as well.

Bill Jenkins: Upcoming Labor Day Campaign - 8/21 to 8/27. Stressed importance of campaign given the stats for fatalities in VT recently.

Discussion of high fatalities over the first weekend in August. Discussion of speed and cell phone use as an issue, and increased enforcement to help deter these behaviors.

Tara Thomas: Reported on VT as one of a few states in the US chosen for an impaired driving rate study. Vermont exceeds the national average. There will be a series of conferences with the GHSA on the collection of data and approach to impaired driving.
